Essential Visitors Policy and Procedure

We recognize the support and reassurance visitors provide for our residents, but the spread of COVID-19 remains in our community, so we have had to implement limits for visitors to keep residents, staff and visitors safe. We are following the status of COVID-19 in our community and will make necessary changes to our visitor policy to prevent the spread of the virus and maintain the safety of everyone.

Essential Visitor Guidelines:

- A. Residents must designate one (1) individual, at least 18 yrs. of age, to visit and serve as the Designated Essential Visitor (DEV).
- B. The DEV shall present to the facility documentation of a negative Covid Test (either PCR or antigen) after 48 hours of testing.
- C. Only one visit per day (24-hour period) will be permitted unless other arrangements have been made with management.
- D. Visitors may stay overnight if arranged with management.
- E. Visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms every time they enter at this facility.
- F. Visitors who do not pass the screening process will not be permitted entry.
- G. Visitors will be asked to provide contact information each time they visit.
- H. Visitors will be given a procedure mask upon entering. Cloth masks and face shield are also allowed.
- I. Masks must be worn at all times.
- J. Residents who are on special precautions may need their visitors to wear gloves and a gown, which will be provided at the facility.
- K. Visitors will only have access to the resident's room and are required to go there directly.
- L. Visitors may exit and re-enter a resident's room no more than once to use the restroom or for other essential needs.
- M. The use of interior public spaces is not permitted; this includes living room area, dining room, or lingering in the hallway.
- N. Visitors are required to comply with all safety protocols, including hand hygiene, masking, and social distancing.
- O. Designated Essential Visitors should avoid attending large gatherings in between testing and visitation. Virtual visits are highly encouraged.
- P. Nananom Assisted Living maintains a Visitor Log for contact tracing purposes.
- Q. When the temperature impacts the ability to safely wait outside, we suggest you do not bring other people with you to our home. We care about your health and safety and the health and safety of your loved ones.

Nananom Assisted Living complies with CDC recommended visitation guidelines and are subject to change according to CDC rulings.
